Join the Marathon Tour to Songpa-gu, Seoul - Christchurch's Korean Sister City. The tour, from 26 September to 5 October will be led by David Bolam-Smith, marathon runner and member of the Christchurch Songpa-gu Sister City Committee.

The marathon, a sister marathon to the SBS Christchurch Marathon, starts and finishes in The Jamsil Olympic Stadium, Songpa-gu, Seoul.

You will:

- be one of 15,000 entrants in the International Peace Marathon - which covers the full marathon, half marathon, 10km and 5km short courses and 3km peace walk
- be hosted to a Civic Welcome by Songpa-gu Office
- experience the wonderful atmosphere of the annual Hansong Baekjae Cultural Festival
- have the unique option to be home hosted by a Korean family for 3 nights
- shop in the markets, including Namdaemun night market
- have time to visit the renowned Lotte World Complex and Theme Park in Songpa-gu and the Olympic Park and Museum, home of the 1988 Olympic Games
- have free time to visit some of Seoul's amazing museums and art galleries

Tour cost \$2500 per person (twin share accommodation).

The tour is fully organised and escorted. Price includes return airfares, airline taxes and surcharge, hotel accommodation (twin share), breakfasts and 3 nights homestay.
